FERROVIAL CONTRIBUTES \$54,000 TO CAPITAL AREA FOOD BANK TO SUPPORT PANDEMIC RELIEF EFFORTS

Fairfax Va. – Ferrovial announced today that it has contributed \$54,465 to the Capital Area Food Bank to support its ongoing efforts to during the COVID-19 pandemic. In Northern Virginia, Ferrovial is the leading entity for I-66 Express Mobility Partners and FAM Construction LLC which are, respectively, developing and building the Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Project.

Ferrovial's contribution is part of the company's international response to the pandemic's impact on vulnerable families and individuals. The effort, *Ferrovial Together COVID-19*, initially contributed \$5.5 million, with a pledge to match donations up to an additional \$5.5 million for a total of \$11 million. To date, the *Ferrovial Together COVID-19* fund has raised approximately \$9.5 million and so far has distributed \$8.16 million to institutions fighting the pandemic in the social, health care and research fields in the United States, Spain and the United Kingdom.

The Fund has now contributed \$176,473 to Virginia non-profit community service organizations during the pandemic, including Capital Area Food Bank, Feed More, and the Foundation for Fairfax County Public Schools. I-66 Express Mobility Partners has also donated \$10,000 to support ACTS and Northern Virginia Family Services in Prince William County.

"The challenge being faced by families across the world – and certainly here in the Washington region – are at a level unlike anything we've ever seen before," said Radha Muthiah, president and CEO of the Capital Area Food Bank. "The support of our community, including the generosity of companies like Ferrovial, is what's enabling us to respond both today and in the coming months and years to the needs of those who are struggling."

In a joint statement, the chief executive officers of I-66 Express Mobility Partners and FAM Construction LLC, Javier Gutierrez and Pablo Molla, respectively, said "The Capital Area Food Bank performs a vital service for those most in need in our community and we are humbled by their tireless efforts to serve families throughout the National Capital area."
